The SolTec initiative will support the employability of solar workers and the competitiveness of the European solar labour market by improving the vocational education and training in the field of service and maintenance.

The SolTec partners seeks to enrol companies and sector stakeholders in the development of a European Qualification Profile fitting for the assignments of service and maintenance, to develop an appropriate modularized curriculum and a European pilot training course to meet these requirements.

SolTec is driven by three key objectives:

- Deliver a European qualification standard for operational skills in the solar energy sector
- Boost the skills capital of the solar energy sector
- Set up an industry-based skills network for the solar energy sector



The AIRE Project

Development and dissemination of an international training in the field of regenerative energy techniques and energy management.

Development and use of **transparency instruments** for comparability of training in Europe. Definition of levels according to the European Qualification Framework, assigning ECVET credit points to modules, definition of parts of the training which can be completed abroad. Application of the EUROPASS instruments.

Networking among training institutions, companies, universities, political decision makers and associations in the field of sustainable energy and education.

Establishment of **certification**, which will facilitate the recognition of achieved partial or total qualifications independent from their school's location.

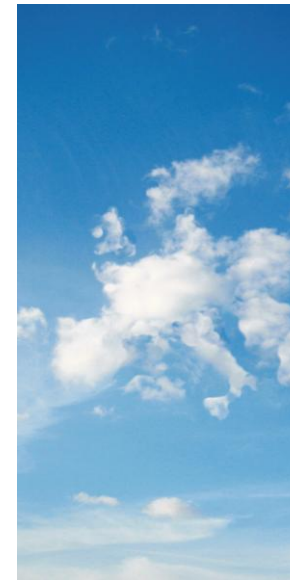
